Requirements IMI Accreditation in Vehicle Damage Assessment:

Vehicle Damage Assessors should be working in the accident repair sector and have at least three years' experience and be familiar with the skills, knowledge and techniques required to determine the vehicle damage, identify the correct safe repair method to return the vehicle back to its pre accident condition.

To achieve accreditation candidates are required to complete a theory assessment (Part A) and a Practical Task (Part B) including vehicle damage circumstances, recording vehicle data, appraising damage and repair specification, using image review to appraise vehicle damage circumstances and vehicle damage.
